Teresa did an excellent overview of the complexities of the Medicare, PPO, HMO, Advantage, and other government insurance planes.

Teresa mentioned that a good source for support would be **HICAP** (**H**ealth **I**nsurance **C**ounseling and **A**dvocacy **P**rogram). **HICAP** provides free, confidential counseling, education, assistance to individuals, their families on Medicare, and other health insurance issues.

Also reviewed where the differences between HMO and PPO planes.

One of the most importance things to remember is that you should not sign anything until you are comfortable with there support and or prosthetic.



Famous Amputee

Alessandro Zanardt Born 23 October 1966, Bologna, Italy

An Italian professional <u>racing driver</u> and <u>paracyclist</u>. He won the <u>CART</u> championships in 1997 and 1998, and took 15 wins in the



series. Zanardi lost both legs (one below and one above the knee) in the impact and nearly threequarters of his blood volume, though rapid medical intervention saved his life. Further portions of his legs were amputated during three hours of surgery to clean and facilitate closing the wounds.

Round Table Meeting (Oct. 22, 2022)Invited speaker: Scott Bourdelais from Canine Companions

Canine Companions employs a breeding program to supply their dogs. They use <u>Golden Retrievers</u> and <u>Labrador Retrievers</u> or crosses of the two breeds.

Puppies are raised by volunteers who commit to keeping the dogs for 18 months, until it is time for them to enter the training program. The service dogs are usually trained for limb loss or

wheelchair bound recipients and are at no charge, The recipients have to go for two weeks of intensive training along with their service dog. 50% of the chosen dogs pass their training and go into service.

Normally only yellow and black labs or golden retrievers are chosen for training.

Applications for service dogs take about 6 months.

If the service dog retires they can stay with their owner if the owner can handle them in addition to their new service dog.

"Canine Companions for Independence" is a US-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that trains and provides assistance dogs. As of 2018, it has placed over 6,000 assistance dogs with recipients at no charge.
